Executive Branch agencies issue regulations with the full force of law, but these are only under the authority of laws enacted by Congress. Article I - The United States Constitution And, because state legislatures controlled their own commerce, the federal Congress was unable to enter into credible trade agreements with foreign powers to open markets for American goods, in part, by threatening to restrict foreign access to the American market. Federalism - American Legislative Exchange Council Article V of the U.S. Constitution provides for the states to call an Amendments Convention when the federal government exceeds its constitutional authority. Amendments to limit the government's power, including a Balanced Budget Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, would help to check federal overreach. Federal Legislative Jurisdiction - State Lands Commission Federal Legislative Jurisdiction. Legislative jurisdiction is the authority to make and enforce laws. A transfer of the state's legislative jurisdiction to the United States is a cession, and the return of that legislative jurisdiction to the state is a retrocession.

Branches of the U.S. Government | USAGov The legislative branch drafts proposed laws, confirms or rejects Presidential nominations for heads of federal agencies, federal judges, and the Supreme Court, and has the authority to declare war. This branch includes Congress (the Senate and House of Representatives) and special agencies and offices that provide support services to Congress.
